Clothing Rules / Pageant Regulations



FIRST REMEMBER THAT WE ARE A NATURAL PAGEANT SYSTEM! ALL HAIR AND MAKE-UP MUST BE AGE APPROPRIATE!

We want the GIRL to shine, NOT the clothes! No fake hair, teeth, etc. are allowed!

Close—Up Appraisal

(Interview)



This is a time for the judges to see contestants up close and get to know them better! Chaperones for 0-2 contestants will introduce their contestant with their name, age (in months) and hometown. They will then tell the judges 2 or 3 fun/interesting facts about their contestant. Contestants ages 3 and up will introduce themselves to the judges by stating their name, age, city, and state followed by a basic pivot. Contestants will then answer a set of age-appropriate questions.

RECOMMENDED ATTIRE: DRESS/PANTSUIT / SKIRT AND TOP/JACKET

Think interviewing for a job!
For younger contestants, we recommend
a nice Sunday's Best Dress. For older
contestants, we recommend a pantsuit or skirt
with top/jacket. We highly suggest either no
sparkle or very little sparkle on outfits! Keep it
simple and classic!

Sportswear Personality

(Casual Wear)



Sportswear Personality is our Casual Wear Competition. This competition is where contestants will introduce themselves in 25 words or less. More instructions can be found later in this handbook. After each contestants has their turn, the whole age group will come back on stage for a parade of beauties.

RECOMMENDED ATTIRE: CASUAL WEAR

Casual Wear should be a pant, short, or skirt outfit, or a dress that shows off their personal style. The outfit can be as simple or as formal as you would like! It should be modest, age—appropriate and should not be high glitz or costume looking.

Party Dress

(Beauty Wear)



Party Dress / Evening Gown is our Beauty Wear competition. All contestants will individually model their beauty wear on stage. Once each contestant has modeled on stage, the whole age group will come back on stage for a parade of beauties.

RECOMMENDED ATTIRE: BEAUTY DRESS

Contestants ages 0—9 should wear a short pageant style dress while contestants ages 10 and up should wear a floor length gown. We love sparkle, but please no glitz dresses!

Additional clothing GUIDELINES

We are a natural pageant system! Clothes should be modest, conservative, and age appropriate! We recommend:

- No slits above the knee
- •No strapless outfits—1" straps for ages 0—12 and at least spaghetti straps for ages 13+
- •No tattoos visible on stage or in interview (This includes 0—2 chaperones)
- •No exposed stomachs or midriffs
- •No overdone jewelry or make—up for younger divisions especially

We are a natural pageant system! Clothes should be modest, conservative, and age appropriate!

Modeling Information

ENTER X EXIT

Stop at each X. Feel free to circle turn or step, step, turn at front X or other X's.

Sportswear Personality



Wait at first X. Go to front X and do introduction.

Wait at front X while emcee reads fact. Exit off stage.

No turns anywhere. No stopping at last "X".

0—2 Contestants BEAUTY WEAR:

Chaperones will model their contestants (see rule below). We recommend turning your baby around at the front X so the judges can see the back of their outfit/hair/etc. Your baby can walk or be carried! It's your choice! Show off your baby, but remember....NO COACHING YOUR BABY ONSTAGE! Audience members can cheer for every contestant, but NO COACHING from the audience either! After every contestant models, we will do either do a parade of beauties or a group line up.

3 and up Contestants BEAUTY WEAR:

Smile big! Don't forget eye contact with the judges! Don't go too fast or too slow! We prefer a nice, natural model! Contestants are free (not required) to do a step-step-turn or circle turn at the front X. We are a natural system and want natural modeling! AVOID sassy walks, hands-on hips, kissy faces, etc. After every contestant models, we will do either do a parade of beauties or a group line up.

SPORTSWEAR PERSONALITY (ALL AGES):

For Sportswear Personality, contestants start at the first X. The emcee will introduce the contestant by saying their #. Contestants will then walk to the microphone at the front X and introduce themselves by saying their name, age, and where they are from. (Chaperones will introduce their 0-2 contestants.) Contestants are encouraged to be creative with their introductions in 25 worlds or less. Following the contestant's introduction, the emcee will say 2 fun facts from off of their emcee card. While those are being read, the contestants just stays there at the front X and smiles (no turns please). When the emcee says "this is contestant #...", the contestant exits the stage (do not stop at last X). After every contestant is done, we will do either do a parade of beauties or a group line up.

On Stage Questions

If the judges request it, ages 3 and up will answer an age-appropriate onstage question at finals.

Hands-On Regulation for 0—2 yrs

ALL contestants in the 0-2 age division have a

HANDS ON RULE

for every competition. For safety purposes, the contestant's chaperone must keep his/her hands on the contestant at ALL times during official competition.

So don't let go on stage! Don't let go in interview!

This does not include the party or optional talent! Let them dance and have fun at the party. If they are competing in optional talent, the chaperone just needs to stand close to them.





Optional Competitions

Optional competitions are offered for extra practice and opportunities for optional category awards. Optional competition results do NOT change the outcome of the official results. All optionals are judged by a separate panel of judges. The official judges do not know who enters or wins the optional categories.

Miss Photogenic

Do you have a beautiful photo? To enter Miss Photogenic, your photo must be emailed to **louisianaolm@gmail.com** by **September 27th, 2024.** No late entries will be accepted. Winner's will receive a full page in the program book along with a crown and banner. Glitz photos are not accepted. Judging is based on beauty, clarity, and personality of photo.



<u>Livin' Doll (Highly Recommended)</u>

Livin' Doll is a fun competition that is judged solely on facial beauty and stage presence by a different panel of judges. All you need is a beauty dress! It can be the same dress that you will wear for the main competition or a different one! **No rules for Livin' Doll dress**, so feel free to bring out the **SPARKLE**! This is a GREAT chance to practice your beauty modeling before the main competition. Winners will crowned right after the event!



Divisions: 0-18 months, 19-36 months, 3-4 years, 5-6 years, 7-9 years, 10-12 years, 13-17 years, 18+ years

Commercial Print Categories

We love to see your print work! Enter your Portfolio, Best Head Shot, Tear Sheets, and/or Zed Cards! Commercial print is judged based on all photogenic aspects: beauty, personality, clarity, and variety. All entries must be turned in at Registration...do not mail these items!!!

- → **Portfolio:** Must be submitted in a picture book of some kind. Must contain 5 or more different shots. Pictures can be any size and picture color does not matter.
- → Best Head Shot: You can enter as many photos as you like for Best Head Shot. Must be individual pictures and should be a head and shoulder shot. Size and color of picture does not matter.
- → **Tear Sheet:** Have you ever been photographed for a magazine, newspaper, or any print item? If so, submit a copy of your work! Items must be fairly recent to your current age. Simply "tear" your work out and compete in Best Tear Sheet!
- → Composite/Zed Cards: Do you have an official modeling composite/zed card that you use at auditions? If not, feel free to make one and enter the Best Comp/Zed Card Competitions. Cards can be any size (5x7 is most popular) and on the front should be your best head shot and on the back should be a variety of your photos. Include your stats—Eye Color, Hair Color, Height, Weight, and any other information you use to book jobs! Color or BW pictures are accepted!

Optional Competitions Continued

Pro Am Modeling (Highly Recommended)

This competition is a fun way to get stage practice while modeling your favorite outfits/costumes. Judging will be based on stage presentation, facial beauty, grooming, and overall personality. Glitz and/or High Fashion model is not required. 1 score sheet per outfit will be given and a 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place will be awarded in each category per age division. This is also a great way to pick which sportswear and/or party dress/evening gown you want to use during official competition if you are having trouble deciding on one! Competition clothing rules, do not apply for Pro Am Modeling! Enter as many as you like, but enter 5 or more and you will be eligible to win sweepstakes for your age division and possibly go on to compete in the Sweepstakes Challenge for the Model of the Year Title (crown, banner, & CASH prize)!




If you enter more than 5 categories, we will take your 5 highest scores for the sweepstakes award.

Categories: Decades Wear, Sportswear, Party Dress/Evening Gown, Rainwear, High Fashion, State/Country Costume, Sleepwear, Western Wear, Coat/Cape Wear, Today's Fad, School Uniform, Suede/Leather Wear, Animal Print, Character Costume, Vintage Wear, TV/Movie Costume, Hat Wear, Team Wear, Under the Sea, Occupation Attire, Swimsuit, and Open Category (anything goes). Back by popular demand = GLAMO-CAMO (100% of the proceeds from your entry into this category will go to Zac's Attack for a Cure and the Lymphatic Education & Research Network. Model a great outfit for a great cause)

Optional Talent

Do you love to perform? Now is your chance! Open to ALL age groups! 1 score sheet per performance will be given and a 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place will be awarded in each category per age division. Please follow OLM guidelines for clothing. All acts must be appropriate for a family audience and talent time cannot exceed 2 minutes! Enter as many as you like, but enter 5 or more and you will be eligible to win sweepstakes for your age division and possibly go on to compete in the Sweepstakes Challenge for the Entertainer of the Year Title (crown, Banner, & CASH prize)!





Categories: Vocal, Dance, Twirling, Instrumental, and Other (Other includes Monologue, Art, Magic, Comedy, Juggling, Sign Language, Ventriloquism, etc.)



Prettiest Eyes, Hair, Smile, Dress & Sportswear—

One winner will be chosen per division per category. These will be judged throughout the entire pageant and the winners will be announced at Special Awards! This is an easy way to compete for extra awards!



<u>Practice Interview (Highly Recommended)</u>

This optional is intended to help you practice your interview skills before the actual event. You will go through a mock interview session and will be given a score sheet with your critiques. This will allow you to feel more confident before entering the real event!



Popular Miss—

Sell ads for our program book and not only get discounts off your fees, but you will also gain points towards our Popular Miss Award. If you sell 5 or more full page ads or a combination of sizes to make full pages, you will be in the running for this award. You will win a free entry to next season's state competition, crown, and banner.



People's Choice Voting—

Online People's Choice voting will take place prior to the state pageant and will conclude before Special Awards. Votes will be \$1 each and can be purchased online by friends and family. This is a great way to show support of your favorite contestant. Not only will the winner receive a **CASH AWARD**, but every contestant that receives votes will earn **HALF** their vote money to be applied to the **WORLD FEES**!!!

One winner per Sweepstakes Division. Banner, Trophy, and **\$50 CASH** award will be presented to each Sweepstakes Divisional Winner.

- *Must enter at least 5 Optional Talent Categories
- *Must enter at least 2 Commercial Print Categories

Sweepstakes Challenge

(Pro/Am Modeling and Optional Talent Only)

Each Sweepstakes Division Winner will compete against each other during the Sweepstakes Challenge for a chance to win the grand prize of an additional \$200 CASH award!

Each sweepstakes award requires a certain amount of entries.

Sweepstakes Challenge Details—All contestants that modeled 5 or more outfits or performed 5 or more talents will be recognized on stage! Then we will name the 4 Sweepstakes Division Winners for Pro/Am and the 4 Sweepstakes Division Winners for Optional Talent. Those winners will then re—compete against the other Sweepstakes Division Winners in their highest scoring Pro/Am or Optional Talent Event. Once every challenger has competed, we will then announce the Model of the Year and the Entertainer of the Year!

Louisiana's Model of the Year & Entertainer of the Year will each receive a

\$200 CASH AWARD!!!
